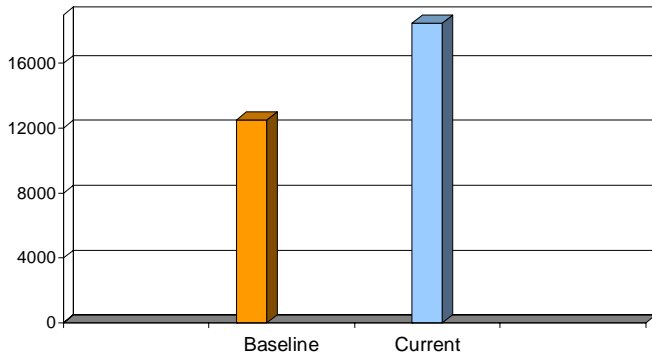
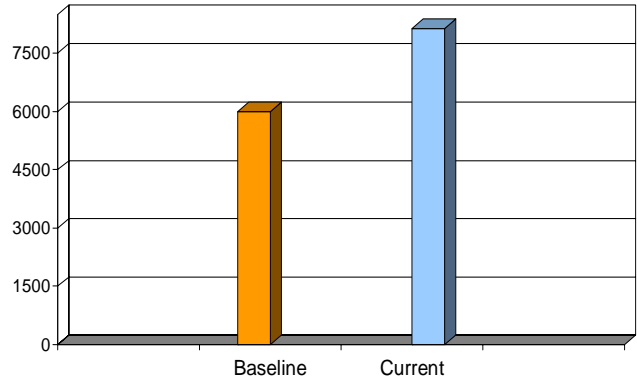

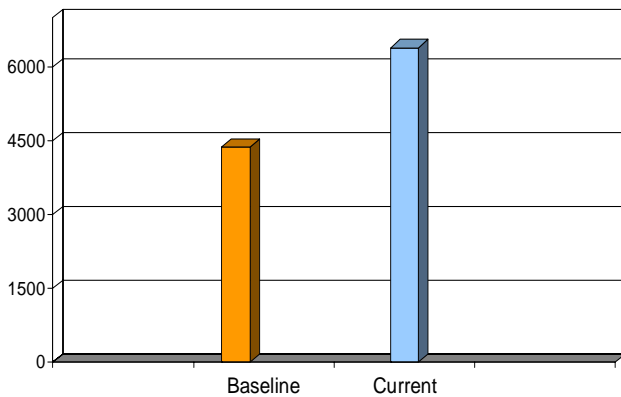
1. There has been a **48%** increase in the number of diagnosed from a baseline of **12,518** patients to a current level of **18,501**.



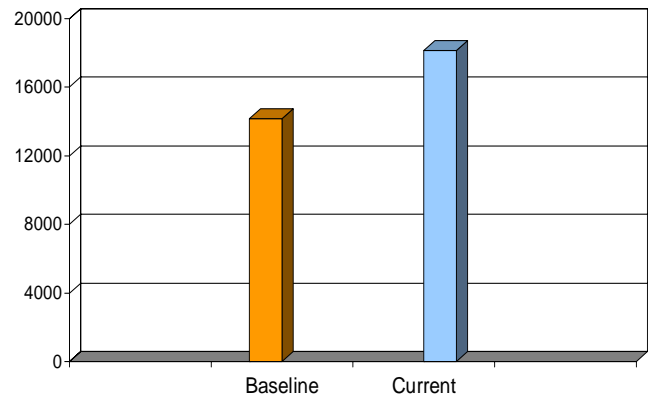
2. There has been a **36%** increase in the number of patients receiving some form of treatment from a baseline of **6,000** patients to a current level of **8,140**.



3. There has been a **46%** increase in the number of PI patients receiving Immunoglobulin therapy from a baseline of **4,367** patients to a current level of **6,389**.



4. There has been a **28%** increase in the number of PI patient referrals from a baseline of **14,173** patients to a current level of **18,135**.



5. There has been a **26%** increase in the number of diagnostic tests performed from a baseline of **45,253** to a current level of **56,992**.
